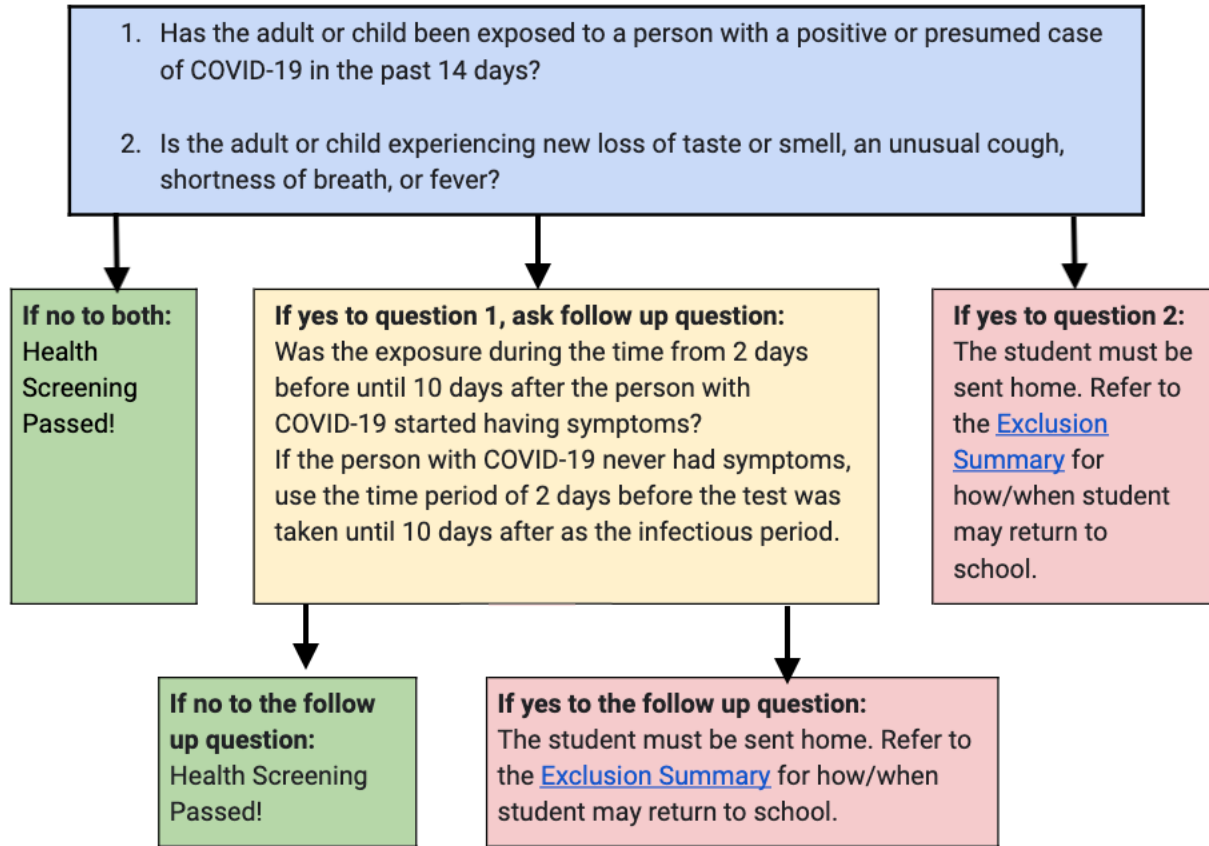


COVID-19 Health Screening Questions:



A **presumptive (presumed) case** is someone who does not have a positive PCR test that confirms if a person has COVID-19, but is showing symptoms and has had close contact with a confirmed case. If they later test positive by PCR, those will be recategorized as confirmed cases.

Fever means 100.4 degrees F or more

Exposure means close contact (less than 6 feet) with a COVID-19 case for 15 minutes or more within a 24 hr period

An **unusual cough** means something not normal for this person (e.g. allergies, asthma).
